

In England, over 111,000 children were registered in autumn 2024, a 21% rise from the previous year (Department for Education, 2024). In Northern Ireland, numbers increased from 2,400 in 2020 to around 3,100 in 2024 (Department of Education Northern Ireland, 2024). Families choose this path for many reasons, including mental health, unmet special educational needs, dissatisfaction with school, lifestyle choices, and the flexibility to create a more personalised education.


